SJR 1 HEALTH CARE (Grendell) Proposing to enact Section 21 of Article I of the Constitution of the State of Ohio to preserve the freedom of Ohioans to choose their health care and health care coverage.

<u>SB 25</u> MEDICAID PAYMENTS (<u>**Tavares**</u>) To specify that the Ohio prompt payment law applies to payment of claims by Medicaid managed care organizations.

<u>SB 26</u> LAB SERVICES (<u>**Tavares**</u>) To prohibit providers of clinical laboratory services from inducing physicians to refer patients in exchange for remuneration and from placing laboratory personnel in physician offices.

SB 55 HEALTH SERVICES (<u>Tavares</u>) To prohibit health insurers from denying payment for a service during or after the performance of the service if the insurer provided prior written authorization for the service.

<u>HB 12</u> MEDICAID SERVICES (<u>Sears</u>) To establish new requirements concerning services, providers, third-party liability, and reports for the Medicaid program.

HB 13 MEDICAID PREMIUM ASSISTANCE (Sears) To require the Director of Job and Family Services to seek federal approval to create a premium assistance component of the Medicaid program.

HB 62 NURSE ASSAULT (Gonzales) To increase the penalty for assault when the victim is a registered nurse or a licensed practical nurse engaged in the performance of official duties whom the offender knows or has reasonable cause to believe is a registered nurse or a licensed practical nurse.

<u>HB 71</u> PRESCRIPTION DRUGS (<u>Luckie</u>) To create the Ohio Official Prescription Program and to require prescribers and pharmacists to obtain information from the Ohio Automated Rx Reporting System.

<u>HB 85</u> HEALTH INSURANCE (<u>Hackett</u>, <u>Sears</u>) To prohibit requiring an individual to obtain or maintain health insurance.
