How CMS Treats Third-Party Billers

- Providers are legally responsible for all actions taken by their employees and companies with whom they contract. • Any legal action falls on the provider of service, not the third-party vendor

- Providers sign Medicare contracts and accept full responsibility of their claims and handling of PHI. Enrollment forms

- Claims submission

- Electronic Data Interchange (EDI)

Note: CMS does not make distinctions between provider and third-party biller agencies
