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



Outcomes from HOD

Policy Proposition 2-24

Codified APMA's support for the unification of the two CPME-recognized certifying boards and supported the cessation of the issuance of a CAQ in surgery.

Budgetary Action Item 3-24

Established a task force to work with a broad group of stakeholders to explore pathways for the unification of the recognized certifying boards. Report shared with profession in October.

Declining Membership

- More members converting to life status
- Fewer young physicians joining or converting from free resident membership
- Large portion of members score as vulnerable or disengaged

- Collaboration with component organizations: FPMB data, communications guidance, participation in membership summit




Research Results

Podiatrists want APMA to focus on advocacy, coding, and online CE. Payer advocacy represents the greatest opportunity for APMA to move the needle



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Advocacy: Center for Professional Advocacy and Federal Advocacy

- VICTORY in DC in averting consolidation of the podiatry board under the medical board
- VICTORY in Alabama to modernize scope
- Potential fix for DEA MATE omissions in Congress
- Ongoing support for Mississippi and Massachusetts in scope battles
- VICTORY MISSION Act and corresponding fixes



Advocacy: Payer Advocacy

- VICTORY on skin substitutes LCDs with the Medicare Part B MACs.
- VICTORY on MIPS hardship exception for providers impacted by Change Healthcare cyberattack.
- VICTORY on Novitas, First Coast, and CGS Part B MACs skin substitutes policy
- VICTORY with Aetna to resolve at-risk foot care with -59 Modifier denials
- VICTORY with CMS on surgical treatment of nails policy for CPT 11750 (nail excision), and working on addressing CPT 11730
- Collaborating with AMA and other stakeholders to oppose new Cigna -25
 Modifier documentation policy
- Leading effort to address LCD/LCA process
- Working with PIMMS and CMS to address ongoing MIPS concerns and MIPS Value Pathways for podiatric physicians
- VICTORY on eliminating Podiatry-Specific E/M G Codes

APMA's work on podiatry-specific E/M codes and -59 Modifier alone has saved members hundreds of millions of dollars.


